



You Too Can Grow Tulips!



Growing tulips from year-to-year requires a cold winter (blue areas on map).

However, tulips can be grown as an annual virtually anywhere in Australia!

To grow tulips as an annual in warm climates, simply follow these instructions:

- Do not purchase your bulbs until March, ideally late March
- After receiving the bulbs, put the bulbs in the crisper of your refrigerator for about 8 weeks until late May or early June
- Plant your tulips in large pots or tubs, water well and place the pot in the coldest part of your garden (no sun) until the bulbs are 10cm tall
- When the bulbs are 10cm tall, move the pot/tub to your ideal display position and enjoy the show
- After flowering has finished discard the bulbs, especially if flowering has occurred before September
- Repeat the experience the following year
- For best results, use Single Late Tulips
